Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy describes how Websome collects, uses, discloses, and protects the personal data of users visiting the website websome.pl, including the websome.pl domain and its subdomains, e.g., www.websome.pl.

Functional Cookies: The website websome.pl uses functional cookies that are necessary to ensure the proper operation of the Website. These cookies do not collect any personal data and are stored on client device.

Marketing Cookies: The website websome.pl does not currently use marketing cookies.

Contact Form: The Website provides a contact form that allows users to get in touch with Websome for the purpose of requesting a quote, consultation, or other additional information. Personal data submitted via the contact form, such as name, email address, phone number, location, or any other information voluntarily provided by the user, will be used solely to address the submitted request and for customer service purposes.
